MEDAL EXAMINATIONS IN CLARINET PLAYING

Examinations for Bronze, Silver and Gold Medals are held in all subjects. Details of requirements are as follows:

Junior Bronze

Two solos from the Grade 3 List
One solo own choice of similar standard

Intermediate Bronze

Two solos from the Grade 5 List
One solo own choice of similar standard

Intermediate Silver

Two solos from the Grade 6 List
One solo own choice of similar standard

Intermediate Gold

Two solos from the Grade 7 List
One solo own choice of similar standard

Senior Bronze

Two solos from the Grade 8 List
One solo own choice of similar standard

Senior Silver

Two solos from the Associate List
One solo own choice of similar standard

Senior Gold

Two solos from the Licentiate List
One own choice solo of similar standard
One of the above should be played from memory.
The candidate should be prepared to discuss with the Examiner the works performed.

Marks

Marks are awarded as follows:

Listed Solos	60
Own Choice Solo	20
Discussion with Examiner	20

The pass mark is 80. No award of Honours or Distinction is made in the Medal Division, but a high standard of performance is expected.
